Your video doesn't have to be perfect and will not be judged on technical ability. Videos will be judged on how they make us feel. A winning video will make us all proud to be part of our community! Showcase your nonprofit's vital mission and the necessity of your programs.

The winners will receive unrestricted grants for:

First Place: \$2,000

Second Place: \$1,000

Third Place: \$500



Additionally, the winning videos will be shown at the Community Foundation's Annual Meeting in 2018.

Don't know how to make a video? It's easy! Check out your phone, camera, or computer — or the closest teenager! Ask your organization's board members, volunteers, and clients to help. Use photos, client testimonials, event footage, interviews... Be creative!

Contest Rules:

- Your video should highlight any project that the Community Foundation supported with any grant since 2013.
- Only one submission per organization, please. If your nonprofit won any of the prizes this year, you are ineligible to re-enter until next year.
- Your video **must not** exceed three minutes in length.
- Please mail or deliver your video in an MP4 or MOV format on a thumb drive to the Community Foundation office BY FRIDAY, January 19, 2018. No submissions via YouTube, please.
- All video entries will be posted on the Community Foundation's website and YouTube page.

Deadline for entries is Friday, January 19, 2018.

Winners will be announced at our Annual Meeting on February 22, 2018.
